## **ATTENTION OWNER/OCCUPANT:**

This letter is to inform you of the current construction activity that will be taking place in the following weeks as part of the **2023 Residential Streets Program**, and to alert you to any minor travel disruptions. Work to be completed by the Contractor as part of this project includes pavement removal, full-depth reclamation of existing pavement, new hot-mix asphalt, aggregate shoulder work, and other related appurtenances. The following locations will be affected by construction activities:

## **Downtown Project**

- 1. Chestnut, Broad, and Harrison Streets from Main Street to 6th Street
- 2. 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, and 6<sup>th</sup> Streets from Chestnut Street to Harrison Street

## Sagewood Subdivision

- 1. Upper Ridge Way from Applegate Drive to McDonald Road
- 2. Applegate Drive from Foxdale Street to Roscoe Township border
- 3. Highstone Drive from Sawmill Drive to Nestlewood Drive
- 4. Sawmill Drive from Applegate Drive to Highstone Drive

The project is anticipated to be completed in phases over a course of approximately 7-9 weeks with a scheduled completion date during the week of September 8th (weather dependent). At minimum, a single lane of traffic with flaggers will be provided at all times throughout the duration of construction, and the contract states that reasonable access to all properties must be maintained at all times. **During this time, on-street parking will be prohibited in construction areas during the hours of 6:00am thru 6:00pm.** This allows the contractor to work more quickly and efficiently throughout the duration of the project.
